GENERAL PURPOSE

Recommended for dairy cows, suckler cows and growing beef cattle

HI PHOS

Contains a high level of available phosphorus to maintain and improve fertility and milk yield

SHEEP

A good general purpose mineral for breeding ewes and growing lambs

MAGNESIUM

Contains 15% magnesium for feeding to all cattle when there is a high risk of hypomagnesaemia (grass staggers)

DRY COW

Low calcium and high phosphorus and magnesium. Also high vitamin E. Formulated for feeding to dairy cows pre-calving.
